Innes Engineering Update - The Pitfalls of Remote Desktop

Remote Desktop Connection (the client side of Remote Desktop) has a hidden option that, in its default setting, will disable all the audio input devices on the host PC as soon as the client connects. This is problematic for applications such as **Flashlog and Delay Master.**

To find and defuse this trap for the unwary, click on **Show Options** when creating or opening a connection:

Click on the **Remote Audio Settings** button and you will see this dialog box:



The default audio playback setting is **Play on this computer**, which creates a virtual audio playback device on the host to route its audio to the client, but in doing so, it disables all existing playback *and recording* devices on the host, even if the remote audio recording setting is left as **Do Not Record**.

The moral of this story? If you're using Remote Desktop to connect to a PC that's recording from, say, a Radcap card, and

you want it to keep doing that, always change the Remote Audio Playback setting to **Play on remote computer**. This will leave all the host's recording (and playback) devices operating normally. The downside is you won't be able to listen to what's playing on the host PC via the network connection.
